OBITUARY

It is with the deepest regret that we have to advise readers of the sudden death of Mr. S.J. Wheaton, Superintendent, on 12th April 1979.

John Wheaton joined the Company in September 1957 as a Junior Engineer. Showing outstanding ability from the outset, he was promoted successively Junior Fourth Engineer, Fourth Engineer, then jumped a rank to Second Engineer by July 1960, finally sailing as Chief Engineer in August 1964.

Appointed Superintendent in 1967, he was taken off normal duties at the end of that year and, together with Captain M.G.B. Thomas, took an intensive Management Training Course at the Royal Naval College at Portsmouth, which was used to good effect in subsequent years to completely overhaul the Technical Department, Ship Operation, Survey and Planned Maintenance procedures.

In 1973, John Wheaton transferred to the Oil Rig Department, which was just being set up and, with easy adaptability, soon gained a full understanding of this new technology and became Engineering Manager of the Drilling Rigs in 1976.

In 1978 he returned to his main interest - Ships - and was placed in charge of the commissioning, in Japan, of the first of a new class of high speed, highly sophisticated, automated vessels being complete, of which we are the Managers. He had not long returned from this when his death came.

Exceptionally talented and modest, John Wheaton was always ready to give assistance and to explain highly technical problems to even the most junior non-technical staff. This likeable man will be sorely missed by colleagues in the Company and in the Shipping Industry and we offer our deepest sympathy to Mrs. Wheaton and their son, Roger.
