MISSIONS TO SEAMEN

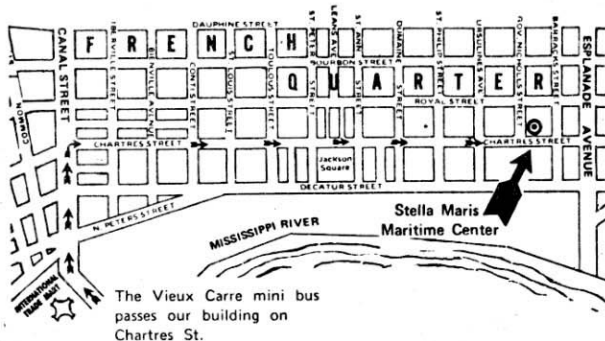
Many seafarers will be unaware that a Missions to Seamen has opened in New Orleans in the French Quarter and has been active since 1st June 1979. Details are:-

SHIPS POSITIONS

As at 24th September, 1979

m.v. "CARDIFF CITY" Vessel presently operating under Berth Service BS.106, arrived Newcastle/Tyne 20th September. ETS 25th September for Tilbury 26/30th, Rotterdam 1/5th October thence Brake 6/8th.

m.v. "DEVON CITY" This vessel is operating under Time Charter account Safmarine loading Steel Products at Durban for West Coast U.S.A. She is scheduled to sail Durban pm 24th September giving ETA Panama Canal 17th October arriving U.S.W.C. 26th.

m.v. "FRESNO CITY" Vessel presently operating under Time Charter account Cast, arrived Turku 18th September probably sailing 26th for Antwerp 28/4th October, thence Jeddah, Sharjah, Dammam and Basrah via Suez Canal.

m.v. "NEW WESTMINSTER CITY" This vessel sailed Port Said 20th September and is expected to arrive Venice am 24th to deliver under Time Charter account MTO. Vessel is scheduled to lift Steel and Generals for discharge Umm Qasr, thereafter redelivering passing Muscat.

m.v. "PORT ALBERNI CITY" This vessel is operating under Time Charter account IVS. She sailed Dubai 16th September for Richards Bay and Durban. ETA Richards Bay 28th probably sailing around 2nd October thence Durban 3/7th for Continent. ETA around 28th October.

m.v. "PRINCE RUPERT CITY" This vessel is presently loading Grain Albany N.Y., for discharge Glasgow. She is expected to sail Albany 25th September giving ETA Glasgow 6th October. Completion discharge Glasgow, intention is for vessel to drydock, probably on the Continent.

m.v. "TACOMA CITY" This vessel is operating under Time Charter account Cast. Berthed Basrah 19th September. ETD 29th September. Vessels next business has not yet been decided.

m.v. "VICTORIA CITY" This vessel is operating under Time Charter account Salen, expected complete discharge and sail Landskrona 24th September for Antwerp, having been nominated to operate under ST.73 loading at Antwerp for Long Beach, Oakland, Portland and New Westminster, this being followed by Berth Service BS.109 loading New Westminster, Eureka, Coos Bay, Crofton and Vancouver BC for discharge London, Boulogne, Rotterdam and Brake.

m.v. "WELSH CITY" Vessel sailed Hamburg 12th September for Houston where she has been fixed to load a cargo of HSS for discharge Hamburg or River Weser. Vessel is expected to arrive Houston 26th September and based on normal loading turn we would look for sailing around 3rd October giving arrival Germany around 18th October.

m.v. "AMPARO" This vessel is presently in drydock at Amsterdam with probable completion around 27th September. She then loads Antwerp, Bremen, Hamburg, Le Havre and Liverpool for discharge and loading operations Vera Cruz, Tampico, Coatzacoalcos, Mobile and New Orleans for return Rotterdam.

m.v. "BIBI" Berthed Pusan 23rd September with probable sailing 24th for Guaymas, Acapulco, Manzanillo, Puntarenas, Acajutla and San Jose.

m.v. "JOSEFA" This vessel sailed Liverpool 17th September for Vera Cruz. ETA 3rd October, thence Tampico, Coatzacoalcos, Progreso, Mobile and New Orleans for Continent.

m.v. "MARIA ELISA" This vessel sailed Morehead City 22nd September with 6036 tons Generals for Naples. ETA 6th October, thence Leghorn, Genoa, Marseilles and Barcelona for Vera Cruz.

m.v. "SAMIA" This vessel sailed Hamburg 23rd September for Gothenburg. ETA 24th September, thence Le Havre, for Vera Cruz, Tampico and Coatzacoalcos.

m.v. "SARA LUPE" This vessel sailed Leghorn 22nd September with expected arrival Marseilles 23rd thence Barcelona for Vera Cruz, Tampico, Coatzacoalcos, Morehead City, thereafter returning to Mediterranean ports.
